

Qualifications for Teaching ACMA 475

Description

ACMA 475 is a specialised upper division course in actuarial science covering pension plan design, regulation, funding, valuation and accounting standards. A project integrating the topics covered is assigned by the instructor. Oral and written communication skills are also evaluated. The audience consists of third and fourth year actuarial science with a strong quantitative background.

Qualifications

Education:

- **Required:**
 - A degree in Actuarial Science or a closely related field.
 - Associate or Fellow of a professional actuarial association.
- **Recommended:**
 - An MSc or PhD degree in Actuarial Science.
 - Research in pension mathematics or a closely related area.

Teaching Experience:

- **Recommended:**
 - Prior teaching experience of actuarial courses with good evaluations.
 - Experience teaching pension courses.

Practical Experience:

- **Required:**
 - At least 2 years of prior experience working with defined benefit pension plans.

Communication:

- **Required:**
 - Excellent oral and written communication skills
